[5]: Temperature coefficient of resistance from 25°C to -55°C for Cold TCR.

Processing

Terminations

 MicromaxTM 002LC were designed for use with high silvercontaining terminations. Reported properties were obtained using MicromaxTM 5426 Ag/Pd termination. Similar performance properties have been observed with other MicromaxTM gold and silver-bearing conductors.

Substrates

 Reported properties are based on tests with 96% alumina substrates. Substrates of other compositions may yield variation in performance properties.

Printing

- The composition should be thoroughly mixed before use. This is best achieved by slow, gently, hand stirring with a clean burr-free spatula (flexible plastic or stainless steel) for 1-2minutes. Care must be taken to avoid air entrapment. Printing should be performed in a clean and well ventilated area.
- Note: optimum printing characteristics are generally achieved in the room temperature range of 20°C - 23°C. It is therefore important that the material, in its container, is at this temperature prior to commencement of printing.

Thinning

 The composition is optimized for screen printing. Thinner is normally not required. Use the Micromax™ recommended thinner for slight adjustments to viscosity or to replace evaporation losses. The use of too much thinner or the use of a non recommended thinner may affect the rheological behavior of the material and its printing characteristics.

Drying

 Allow prints to level at room temperature. Then dry in a well ventileted oven or conveyor dryer.

Firing

- 850°C peak held for 10 minutes on 30 minutes firing cycle.
- Fire in a well ventilated belt, conveyor furnace, or static furnace.
 Air flows and extraction rates should be optimized to ensure that oxidizing conditions exist within the muffle, and that no exhaust gases enter the room.

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Properties

 Information in this datasheet shows anticipated typical physical properties for MicromaxTM 00L2C based on specific controlled experiments in our labs and are not intended to represent the product specifications, details of which are available upon request.

General

Performance will depend to a large degree on care exercised in screen printing. Scrupulous care should be taken to keep the composition, printing screens and other tools free of metal contamination. Dust, lint and other particulate matter may also contribute to poor yields.

Storage and shelf life

Containers should be stored, tightly sealed, in a clean, stable environment at room temperature 0-5 °C. Shelf life of material in unopened containers is six months from date of shipment.

Some settling of solids may occur and compositions should be thoroughly mixed prior to use.
