## Design & compatibility

#### Design

o For detailed recommendations on use of Micromax™ GreenTape™ 9KC and conductors such as Micromax™ 9C601, see the Micromax™ GreenTape™ 9KC Design Guide Addendum and Micromax™ GreenTape™ 9KC Product Data Sheet. We recommended printing over the backing of the tape. For compatible co-fired and post fired conductor compositions, consult your Micromax™ representative.

# **Processing**

#### Printing

- The composition should be thoroughly mixed before use. This is best achieved by slow, gentle hand stirring with a clean burr-free spatula (flexible plastic or stainless steel) for about 1-2 minutes. Care must be taken to avoid air entrapment. Printing should be performed in a clean and well-ventilated area.
- Note: Optimum printing characteristics are generally achieved in the room temperature range of 20°C - 23°C. It is therefore important that the material, in its container, is at the temperature prior to commencement of printing. Viscosity, and therefore printability, of thick film compositions can be affected by ambient temperatures.
- From vias in unfired Micromax<sup>TM</sup> GreenTape<sup>TM</sup> 9KC and then print Micromax<sup>TM</sup> 9C601 directly into vias using through-hole screen printing methods and a stencil mask. A vacuum stone or other support structure that uniformly distributes vacuum to the Micromax<sup>TM</sup> GreenTape<sup>TM</sup> 9KC green sheet is recommended.

1-Propoxy-2-Propanol

## Drying

 Dry in air in a well-ventilated oven or conveyor dryer for 5 minutes at 120°C. Do not over-dry. See material Safety Data Sheet for additional information.

#### Lamination and firing

 Laminate multiple sheets of Micromax<sup>™</sup> GreenTape<sup>™</sup> 9KC onto which Micromax<sup>™</sup> 9C601 has been printed according to processing parameters detailed in the Micromax<sup>™</sup> GreenTape<sup>™</sup> 9KC Design Guide Addendum and on the Micromax<sup>™</sup>

# **Properties**

#### General

Performance will depend to a large degree on care exercised in screen printing. Scrupulous care should be taken to keep the composition, printing screens and other tools free of metal contamination. Dust, lint and other particulate matter may also contribute to poor yields.

## Storage and shelf life

Containers should be stored, tightly sealed, in a clean, stable environment at room temperature (<25°C). Shelf life of material in unopened containers is six months from date of shipment. Some settling of solids may occur and compositions should be thoroughly mixed prior to use.
