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

Processing

- Substrates
 - Polycarbonate, surface-treated polyester
- Screen types
 - Polyester, stainless steel
- Printing
 - Reel-to-reel, semi-automatic or manual
- Typical layer thickness
 - 11 μm per layer
 - o Printed with 250-36 stainless steel screen on PC.
- Work life
 - ∘ < 1 hour
- Clean-up solvent
 - Ethylene glycol diacetate
- Drying
 - Box oven: 120°C for 20 minutes in a well-ventilated oven
 - o Reel-to-ree I: 120 °C for 4 minutes in a well-ventilated tunnel dryer

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

Storage and shelf life
