Processing Notes

### Pre-Drying

FORTRON should in principle be predried. Because of the necessary low maximum residual moisture content the use of dry air dryers is recommended. The dew point should be ≤ - 30 ° C. The time between drying and processing should be as short as possible.

### Storage

For subsequent storage the material should be stored dry in the dryer until processed (≤ 60 h).
