



ACETAL RESIN

Common features of Delrin® acetal resins include mechanical and physical properties such as high mechanical strength and rigidity, excellent fatigue and impact resistance, as well as resistance to moisture, gasoline, lubricants, solvents, and many other neutral chemicals. Delrin® acetal resins also have excellent dimensional stability and good electrical insulating characteristics. They are naturally resilient, self-lubricating, and available in a variety of colors and speciality grades.

Delrin® acetal resin typically is used in demanding applications in the automotive, domestic appliances, sports, industrial engineering, electronics, and consumer goods industries.

Delrin® 500CL is a medium viscosity acetal homopolymer containing a chemical lubricant, designed for low wear and friction against metals.

 \cdot $\,$ When the material is not properly stored in a dry place at room temperature, or

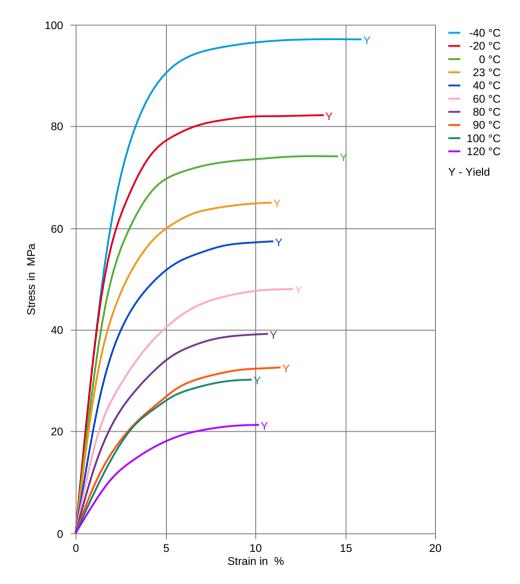
When packaging stays open for a significant time.





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Stress-strain

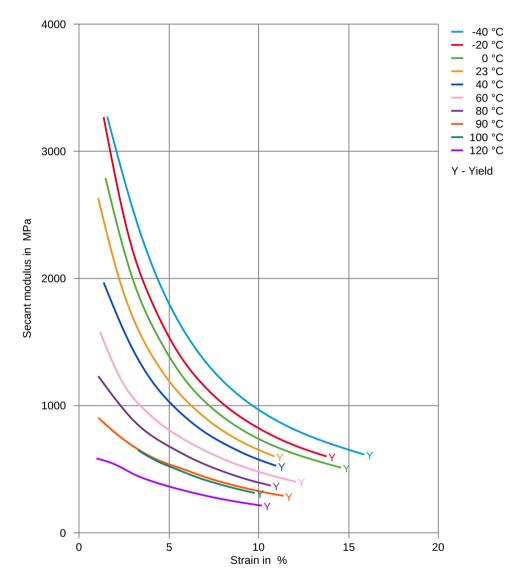






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Secant modulus-strain
